

SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCES CHEAT SHEET

CENTERVILLE:

- Can travel on city streets in a manner to get to lakes and snowmobile trails and must take a direct route to and fro. 72.04 sub d
- Can also travel to gas station and or restaurant direct route 72.04 sub e
- Prohibited use on public lands, parks, cemeteries, schools, etc. 72.05 sub a
- Speed limit on city streets is 20mph and single file 72.04 sub d
- Hours of operation 12:01am and 7:00 am are prohibited 72.06
- Prohibited use within 50 feet of any fisherman, fish house, pedestrian, skating rink, or sliding area 72.05 sub b

CIRCLE PINES:

- Can travel on city streets only the most right-hand lane or close as practicable to right hand curb 1120.03 sub a
- Prohibited use on sidewalk, on boulevards within public right away on private property without consent 1120.03 subs b,c,d
- Speed limits 10mph on city streets 1120.03 sub g
- Hours of operation Sunday thru Thursday 10:00 pm til 7:00 am prohibited 1120.03 sub h(i)
- Hours operation prohibited on weekends 12:00am til 8:00 am 1120.03 sub h(ii)
- Speed limit of Rice Creek Trail along Lake Drive 30mph 1120.03 sub j
- Prohibited use within 200 feet of church property during hours of service 1120.03 sub i

LEXINGTON:

- Can travel on city streets only the most right hand lane or close as practicable to right hand curb 8.30 sub 5 a
- Prohibited use on sidewalk or trail designed for pedestrians 8.30 sub 5 b
- Prohibited use of any public right away 8.30 sub 5c
- Hours of operation prohibited Sunday thru Thursday 10:00pm- 7:00 am 8.30 sub 5 i
- Hours of operation prohibited weekends 12:00 am – 8:00am 8.30 sub 5 12
- Speed limit on city streets 10 mph 8.30 sub 5 g
- Speed limit of Rice Creek Trail Lake Dr 30 mph 8.30 sub 5 h
- Prohibited use playgrounds, parks, school grounds etc 8.30 sub 5 f
- Prohibited use within 200 feet of church during service hours 8.30 sub 5 j

CIRCLE PINES AND LEXINGTON HAVE BASICALLY THE SAME ORDINANCES
